The Public Hospitals Authority (PHA) and the Sandilands Rehabilitation Centre prepare to bid fond farewell to Hospital Administrator Ruth Albury as she commences pre-retirement leave this month. Ms. Albury was confirmed as Hospital Administrator July 2016, capping forty-six (46) years of outstanding service in healthcare.

Ms. Albury began her career in nursing in 1976 at the Princess Margaret Hospital. A firm believer in the importance of professional development and continuing education, she obtained advanced training and certification in Critical Care Nursing and Midwifery. Upon completion of a graduate degree in Nursing Services Management from the University of Manchester, England, Ms. Albury served for over eleven years in Nursing Administration before becoming Deputy Hospital Administrator in 2005.

In 2007 Ms Albury joined the vibrant and diverse Sandilands Rehabilitation Centre family, serving as Deputy Hospital Administrator. During her tenure as Hospital Administrator at Sandilands, Ms Albury was a key player in the relocation of the Community Counselling and Assessment Centre to its new facility on Collins Avenue. She accelerated the transformation of the institution's Fox Hill campus with the enhancement of outdoor therapeutic environments like the gazebo and fountain garden made possible by the generous donation of the Chinese Embassy.

She will be succeeded by Ms. Mary Walker, formerly Hospital Administrator at the Princess Margaret Hospital.
